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Introduction

The TPX facility allows you to log on one time to access multiple mainframe sessions, such as TCS, CMTS and COED. Due to the implementation of the new CMTS system, you will no longer be able to log on directly to TCS. If you try to log directly into TCS, you will receive the following message:

```
DIRECT LOGON TO TCS NO LONGER SUPPORTED. USE TPX TO LOGON TO TCS.  
CALL OSS FOR ASSISTANCE 8-992-5555 OR 8-271-5555
```

Therefore, you will be required to log on to TPX. This guide provides instructions on how to accomplish the log on to TPX.

VTAM Menu

To begin, the VTAM menu displayed below must be displayed on your screen.

The cursor should be in the lower left hand corner of the screen. To log on:

1. Type **TPX**.
2. Press <ENTER> key.

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The TPX Logon screen is returned:

1. Type your **User ID** in the USER ID field.
2. TAB to the PASSWORD field and type your **Password**.
3. Press <ENTER> key.

The TPX Menu is returned.

To change your password

TAB to the NEW PASSWORD field and type in a **new password**. Press <ENTER> key.

Remember the following rules for passwords:

- Must be 6-8 characters in length.
- May contain letters and numbers.
- Cannot use repeating characters side by side.
- Cannot be your User ID.
- Should not be obvious values (such as your name, SSN, phone number, etc.).
- Must be changed every 90 days (you will receive a reminder notice).

From this TPX Menu you can activate any of the sessions displayed. Since you already entered your User ID and password on the TPX log on screen, you will automatically be logged in to the session you activate.

To Activate a Session

1. Move the cursor to the left of the session you want to activate.
2. Press <ENTER> key.

You can continue to activate additional sessions from the TPX Menu.

NOTE: CMTS will not be available to you until your region is cut over to the new CMTS system. You will be notified when it becomes available to you.

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To Return to TPX Menu from a Session

To return to the TPX Menu from an activated session, press the <PA1> (PAGE UP key).

To Jump between Sessions

If you have more than one system activated, you can jump directly between the activated sessions without returning to the TPX Menu by pressing the <PA2> (PAGE DOWN key).

To Log Off a Session

To log off any session that has been activated:

1. Follow normal log off procedures for that session (e.g., for TCS, type **logoff**).
2. Press <ENTER> key.
The TPX Menu is displayed.

To Log Off TPX

To log off TPX:

1. On the TPX Menu in the COMMAND line, type **/K**.
2. Press <ENTER> key.
The VTAM menu is once again displayed.

Automatic Log Off

If all sessions remain inactive for 10 minutes, you will automatically be logged off and the VTAM Menu returned.
